Academically Excellent


We will accelerate learning, holding a high bar for all students with in person and virtual support, because we believe in the potential of all of our students.




Flexible and Responsive

We are creating a comprehensive plan for the upcoming school year, but will stay flexible and responsive to both students' and families' needs and public health guidance in our individual communities.


AS A PARENT, YOU CAN EXPECT

Responsive support services for children with disabilities, and built-in language services for children learning English.






Clear and transparent attendance policy to support school engagement, with communication and support.

A healthy balance of developmentally appropriate on-screen and off-screen learning opportunities




Live movement opportunities with teachers and access to on-demand enrichment activities including outdoor play activities



Daily small interactive play groups with teachers and classmates to build social connection




Weekly check-ins with teachers to address individual student and family needs


